

SFY 2015 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

February Invoice Report

Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 14 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 14 FQHCs, 9 submitted invoices, and of these 9, only 2 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.





UCF Reimbursement



For services provided in February, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 1,255 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$276,096.87

Total UCF Available = \$212,706.41

Each qualifying FQHC received 77% of their requested reimbursement amount.
