The Oklahoma State Immunization Information System (OSIIS) is a confidential, comprehensive database of immunizations administered to Oklahomans by participating providers. The goal of OSIIS is to reduce vaccine-preventable disease by supporting timely and complete immunizations for all Oklahomans.

Getting Started with OSIIS

Identify an OSIIS Administrator for your site. This person will be responsible for maintaining users and user access and will be your site's main OSIIS contact.

The OSIIS Administrator is responsible for submitting the necessary documentation for the site to gain access to OSIIS.
