Update on the Development of the "Uniform Employment Application for Nurse Aide Staff"

As mandated by HB 2019 passed this past legislative session, OSDH in conjunction with the DHS Office of the Ombudsman has developed a draft Uniform Employment Application for Nurse Aide Staff. Statutory requirements mandate that this form be used by facilities which employ nurse aides effective January 1, 2001. These facilities include nursing and specialized nursing facilities, residential care homes, continuum of care facilities, adult day care centers, assisted living centers, hospice agencies and programs, and home care agencies.

A work group of facility and association representatives have been meeting to provide input into the development of the form. This Work Group met for the last time December 19, 2000. The final drafting of the form will occur via electronic communications. Once the form is complete it will be sent to all facilities with instructions for use. It is anticipated that the form will be available shortly after the New Year.
