## INTRODUCTION

This report includes psychiatric facility utilization data for the six-month period from [September 2006](#) through [February 2007](#). The occupancy information for this report was provided by the State Health Department, pursuant to Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 1-880.4 and 1-880.7.

**The statewide occupancy rate, number of facilities, and number of beds is provided on the statewide summary page at the end of this report.**

The report consists of two parts, the first part including the following information:

- \* county in which the facility is located;
- \* name of the facility;
- \* number of licensed psychiatric youth, and adult beds at the facility;
- \* number of psychiatric days, including patient service days, and reserve days for both youth and adult;
- \* psychiatric services occupancy rate (%) at the facility for the six month period for youth, adult and the two combined;
- \* occupancy rate (%) for all services at the facility for the six month period.

**The second part including:**

- \* totals for the entire state, for youths, adults, and the two groups combined.
