

Guide to Immunizations **Required** to Attend Childcare in Oklahoma

Children attending childcare centers or homes are required to be up-to-date for their age for the vaccines listed in the chart below. This chart shows the recommended ages for the required doses of vaccines.

The next chart shows when the vaccine doses are "Past Due". For example, dose #1 HepB vaccine is due at birth and is past due at 2 months of age.

This chart shows when children are "Past due" for the required doses of vaccines. Match the color and dose number of the dose in the top chart to the same dose color and number in the bottom chart to find out when a dose is "Past Due".

Some children will receive a total of 4 doses of Hib vaccine and some will receive only 3 doses depending on the brand of Hib vaccine used. Children who receive the brand of Hib vaccine that totals only 3 doses do not get the 3rd dose until 12-15 months of age, so they are not "Past Due" for the 3rd dose until 16 months of age.

PCV	pneumococcal conjugate vaccine
Polio	inactivated polio vaccine

Varicella	varicella (chickenpox) vaccine
HepA	hepatitis A vaccine
