I am excited to share with you that the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) will launch the new Oklahoma State Immunization Information System (OSIIS) next month!

Beginning in February, this new system will still have all the features of the current system, but we have incorporated new features – including a new, integrated forecaster (status screen) – to provide you with more updated technology and a more user-friendly interface. Several teams at the OSDH have integrated your feedback and needs into this new OSIIS and we are very excited about its launch.

Next week you should receive a message from your Immunization Field Consultant (IFC) with details about new OSIIS training options and opportunities. Your current username and password will give you access to the new system, and we believe it is user-friendly and easy to navigate; however we will provide live webinars and other training material for you to use.

As you may know, our current OSIIS is nearly 20 years old and was becoming more difficult to modify and maintain. Later in the year, the new system will have the ability to be interoperable with electronic health record systems.
