1. Can other methodologies besides filter paper be used for testing?

Solicitation says "filter paper, capillary tube, or venous methodology"

2. Who and/or where has testing been done prior?

The contractor for the fiscal year 2016 (July 01, 2015 through June 30, 2016) is Tamarac Medical.

3. Where and by whom will these be collected?

Samples will be collected by county health department staff at local county health departments in Oklahoma.

4. How will they be sent to the laboratory for testing? Mail, courier, etc?
