Kingfisher Community Collaborative, Inc. (KCC) was initially organized in 1997 and has worked to assist our schools and improve communication among the many area help agencies and organizations. The Collaborative role in the community is always evolving based on the culture and issues impacting the county. The KCC has been intentional to listen to the needs of the community and responding. The KCC has been successful in sustaining projects that have proven outcomes and recognized those that have not.

KCC is committed to the health and well-being of the youth and families of Kingfisher County. We value the health and well-being of Kingfisher County children and families.

This year KCC collaborated with the Kingfisher Schools to hold a six week "Walking Wednesday program". This brought in over 60

youth that participated each week. This program was part of the continued funding from the previous Safe Routes to School Grant.

This year KCC received a \$20,000 grant in collaboration with Blaine and Logan Counties to provide information resources on infant mortality. KCC along with Smart Start Kingfisher County and the Kingfisher County Health Department, hosted their first annual Community Baby Shower and Car Seat Safety Event to offer Free resources, education and skills to new moms, dads and families raising kids to help, not only lower the infant mortality rates of Oklahoma but to also help parents in Kingfisher County raise healthy babies.

According to the 2012 County Health Rankings, Kingfisher County ranks 8th out of 77 counties. KCC prides themselves on their efforts to promote health in Kingfisher resi-

dents whether its communities, schools or businesses.

All of Kingfisher Public Schools are Tobacco Free 24-7. Out of 15 public schools all but 5 were certified healthy schools. Okarche Public Schools received an incentive grant through the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET) to better improve the health of their students. Congratulations Okarche Public Schools!


