



About Us...

The Logan County Partnership originated as the Logan County Networking Group, and has been a cornerstone of community collaboration since the first meeting in 1989. The first efforts focused on identifying social and community health issues adversely effecting Logan County residents. Over time the coalition's goals were increasingly guided by the Healthy People 2010 initiative. The mission of the Logan County Partnership is to improve the quality of life for Logan County citizens through sharing resources, networking, creating awareness, identifying gaps in services, and advocating.

The Logan County Partnership is striving to create healthier residents by engaging the community to assess the health status of county residents. The Coalition is using the Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnerships (MAPP) model as a tool to collect data for developing strategies to improve health. MAPP consists of four assessment methods in a structured process for gathering and utilizing data for intervention strategies. Using these 4 assessments provides for a compre-

hensive view of the current health status, as well as the factors, both real and perceived, that influence this community's health.

The top five elements of health were identified for Logan County. They include:

- Child Health
- Fitness and Nutrition
- Poverty/Access to Care
- Sexual health
- Substance abuse

The Coalition, along with the community, is working towards creating their strategic Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) in order to establish policy change, educate and promote a healthier quality of life and also to leverage potential resources within the community.

This year the coalition also received a \$20,000 grant in collaboration with Blaine and Kingfisher Counties to provide information resources on infant mortality. The partnership, along with Smart Start Logan County and the Logan County Health Department, hosted their first annual Community Baby Shower and Car Seat Safety Event

to offer free resources, education and skills to new moms, dads and families raising kids to help lower the infant mortality rates of Oklahoma and help parents in Logan County raise healthy babies.

The Logan County Partnership is also the funded coalition for the TSET Nutrition and Fitness grant. "Get Fit Logan County" is a sub-committee of the Logan County Partnership and had the opportunity this grant year to bring in a highly qualified speaker to present and train city officials on the importance of Complete Streets. This workshop took the city officials a step further and educated on how to a resolution into an ordinance. Because the coalition is working on ways to creating healthy options for communities, businesses, and schools, Logan County is on its way to being a healthy place to work, live and play.
