The Logan County Partnership originated as the Logan County Networking Group, and has been a cornerstone of community collaboration since the first meeting in 1989. The first efforts focused on identifying social and community health issues adversely effecting Logan County residents. Over time the coalition's goals were increasingly guided by the Healthy People 2010 initiative. The mission of the Logan County Partnership is to improve the quality of life for Logan County citizens through sharing resources, networking, creating awareness, identifying gaps in services, and advocating.

One of the projects the group partnered on this year has been the Smart Start Logan County Intergenerational Classroom. They recog-

nized the importance of establishing a connection, and a relationship across generations. These classrooms help connect the historical perspective of who we are with the future perspective of all that we can become. Through collaboration with Guthrie Public Schools, Companion Healthcare and a local Senior Living Center, Guthrie will soon be home to a full day Pre-K public school classroom located on-site at Willow Creek Nursing Home. Connecting elders and young children provides rich opportunities for interaction and helps bring together two of the most vulnerable age groups in the community—elders with rich life experiences to share, and young children—in need of the patience and wisdom that age can offer.

Nutrition and Fitness are also key priorities of the Logan County Part-

nership. In June 2011, the coalition was awarded the Communities of Excellence in Nutrition and Fitness grant from the Oklahoma Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust. This grant opportunity will reduce obesity and increase physical activity in Logan County. During this “planning” year, the “Get Fit Logan County” subcommittee has been working to increase community knowledge and participation. The City of Guthrie partnered with God’s Food Bank this year to create a community garden in which Guthrie residents can receive fresh produce, as well as learn how to garden and prepare garden fresh food.
