The Logan County Partnership originated as the Logan County Networking Group, and has been a cornerstone of community collaboration since the first meeting in 1989. The first efforts focused on identifying social and community health issues adversely affecting Logan County residents. Over time the coalition's goals were increasingly guided by the Healthy People 2010 initiative. The mission of the Logan County Partnership is to improve the quality of life for Logan County citizens through sharing resources, networking, creating awareness, identifying gaps in services, and advocating.

Since Completing the Community Health Improvement Plan, the Logan County Partnership has been working on implementing their strategies in their community around their five priorities. They include:

- Child Health
- Fitness and Nutrition
- Poverty/Access to Care
- Sexual health
- Substance abuse

This year the coalition focused on ad-

ressing child health through child abuse awareness month in April. The coalition hosted a Touch a Truck event. This event draws in about 200 people every year. While this is a great opportunity for kids to learn and meet the leaders of the community, it is also beneficial for parents and families as well. At the event parents are given the necessary resources and tools in order to protect, educate, and care for their kids. By creating the positive support group and environment for these families we hope to see a decrease in child abuse cases in Logan Co.

Also this year the Fitness and Nutrition group has done several projects to continue the complete streets through the City of Guthrie. The Get Fit Logan County group was instrumental in getting bike racks at several locations around the city as well as hosting the Bike to Work event. This event raised awareness about complete streets for all modes of transportation, increased physical activity, and also awareness and education for sharing the road. Several people participated in this event, including city leaders, law enforcement, and avid bike riders.

In the 1st year of implementation for the CHIP the Logan County partnership has seen new partnerships formed as well as new ideas and strategies brought to the coalition in order to make Logan county healthy. Logan County Partnership has recently become a Certified Health Improvement Organization (CHIO). This will give the coalition the opportunity to apply for grant funding to work specifically with primary care providers on prevention efforts in the community. This has not been done yet with this group so we look forward to the impact that it can bring to Logan County.
