

Guidelines for Take Charge! Funded Breast Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Services

Section 1: Eligibility

All statements in the table below must be answered "yes" in order to proceed.

Demographic Eligibility
Is between 40-64 years of age
Has income at/or below 185% of current federal poverty level. See income table and instructions below
Has no health care insurance including Medicare or Medicaid or insured with an unmet deductible of over \$150
Not eligible for Oklahoma Cares due to one or more of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • non qualifying abnormal breast finding including short term follow-up • citizenship status • non-compliance with child support enforcement
Self declares is a resident of Oklahoma

Section 2: Income

Income is based on total family income which includes: wages, tips, savings, net income from farm self-employment, unemployment compensation, alimony, royalties, rental income, pension, savings or bonds. Family income is basically any income or funds the woman has access to for the purchase of food, clothing, shelter, entertainment or health care. Income guidelines are based on 185% of the current Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG). If the person makes **more** than amount listed for the size of the family unit, they do not qualify. The FPG is updated annually. **Patient's statement accepted.** There is no need to verify income by reviewing checking stubs, tax records, etc.

For each additional person over 12 in the family unit add \$7,659.00 per person annually

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Section 3: Medical Eligibility

The abnormal breast finding has to have been identified by a Take Charge! provider for women 40-64 years of age and the results must indicate one of the abnormal findings below. **The Take Charge! program does not cover abnormalities that are not related to breast cancer.**

Descriptions

Prior proven BRCA mutation documentation (Documentation required)
A first-degree relative who is a documented BRCA carrier
A lifetime risk of 20-25% or greater defined by BRCAPRO model
Post breast cancer treatment and have an imaging result of Bi-Rads® 3 or greater

Section 4: Scheduling Appointments

Eligible women will be scheduled at a Take Charge! contracted facility. The facilities contracted to provide MRI are listed on the Take Charge! website at <http://takecharge.health.ok.gov>.

Process

Ensure client has a current Take Charge! card and determine eligibility for MRI
Fax de-identified medical records showing breast abnormalities listed above and any other applicable breast related findings to 405-271-6315 to the attention of Take Charge! Patient Navigator
The Take Charge Patient Navigator will fax the de-identified medical records to the Take Charge! Medical Breast Consultant for review and approval. After a request has been reviewed the Take Charge! Patient Navigator will fax back the approval or denial
Call and schedule appointment at Take Charge! contracted facility based on appointment availability
Complete the Screening and Diagnostic Coupon ODH Form No. 833
Give the first 2 copies of the completed ODH Form No. 833 to the client with instructions to take it to the appointment. The last page of the coupon should be filed in the client's chart

If a service is not listed on the Screening and Diagnostic Coupon ODH Form No. 833, Take Charge! is unable to pay for the service. Take Charge! cannot pay for treatment of breast or cervical cancer.
