About Us...

The Major County Sooner SUCCESS Coalition is a unique partnership of community organizations, agencies, mental health providers, civic groups, school professionals, family members, and individuals committed to improving the quality of life for children with special needs and their families residing in Major County. Special needs include developmental, emotional, physical, mental, and abuse/neglect issues.

The Major County Sooner SUCCESS Coalition is a co-parent coalition with Woods County Coalition for the TSET Tobacco Prevention Coalition in Major County. This year the coalition worked on tobacco prevention, education and cessation through advocacy and tobacco free policies in Major County. This grant year the Fairview SWAT Team at-

tended the TSET Day at the capital and then attended the NWOA Legislative Reception at the Oklahoma History Center with Governor Fallin. The students talked to Governor Fallin about all their work and what they have done in their communities. The Fairview SWAT Team and Major County Coalition picked up 3260 cigarettes butts downtown and at their local school. The students presented to the Fairview city council on adopting a Clean Indoor Ordinance and Tobacco Free Parks. All council members were in favor of this action and plans to adopt it for their community.

Also, this year the Major County Sooner SUCCESS coalition provided 15 care packages to DHS for Major County children that were taken into DHS custody. The Care Packages included a bag, a blanket, essential toiletry needs, and a stuffed animal to help the child to adjust in their new placement home.

The Coalition continued their efforts to provide food to chronically hungry children during the summer months, supporting the mentor program for children and youth and aiding in CASA program in Major County. Because of other health factors emerging, the Sooner Success Coalition has become partners with the Fairview Fitness Future to work on an integrated Walking Trail for Fairview as well as a Wellness Challenge for residents of Major County.

According to the County Health Rankings in 2012, Major County ranked 16 out of 77 counties in Oklahoma which is better than in 2010 when they ranked 25th. Major County Sooner SUCCESS coalition and partners are striving to make Major County a healthier place to live, work, and play.
