The Major County Sooner SUCCESS Coalition is a unique partnership of community organizations, agencies, mental health providers, civic groups, school professionals, family members, and individuals committed to improving the quality of life for children with a special need and their families residing in Major County. Special needs include developmental, emotional, physical, mental, and abuse/neglect issues. The coalition began in January 2003 and soon became a Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth Community Partnership Board for Major County. In January 2012 the coalition voted

to become a Turning Point Coalition.

The Coalition is actively striving to make Major County a healthier place to live through efforts including providing food to chronically hungry children during the summer months, supporting a mentor program for children and youth, aiding in the implementation of a CASA program, addressing underage drinking and tobacco use, partnering to provide a safe, educational, supervised place for elementary children during the spring weeks of no school on Fridays, and providing free educational workshops to the community. An ABCD3

partnership with Garfield County enhances child development by improving care coordination and linkages among primary care providers (PCPs) and other providers of community services for young children and their families.

The coalition members have recently started looking at plans to implement a Systems of Care Partnership with Woods and Alfalfa County Coalitions. They also have begun a project to put together 12 sets of bags, blankets and stuffed animals for children in Major County taken into custody by DHS.
