Newborn Screening Results

Web-based System

To assist health care providers in ensuring every newborn is adequately screened, the Newborn Screening Program of the Oklahoma State Department of Health has established the **Newborn Screening Results (NBSR)** web-based system.

How to set up a NBSR account:

1. Select an Account Representative.

👣 They will be responsible for managing individual user's accounts for your site.

2. Account Representative must contact the Public Health Laboratory:

Include your name, email address, clinic name, clinic address, clinic phone, and physicians practicing at your site.

3. A login will be assigned to the Account Representative and provided via email.

4. Log into the NBSR and create a personal password.

👣 The Account Representative will have the ability to set up other users for their site.

Reminder: To prevent morbidity and mortality, all Oklahoma newborns are required to have a screening blood and hearing test. Blood screening includes congenital hypothyroidism, galactosemia, amino acid disorders including phenylketonuria (PKU), sickle cell disease, congenital adrenal hyperplasia, cystic fibrosis, fatty acid disorders including medium chain acyl CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCAD), organic acid disorders, biotinidase deficiency and Severe Combined Immunodeficiency (SCID).
