

NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE CORPS (NHSC) SCHOLARSHIPS & LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM

For a two-year service commitment, receive up to \$50,000 to repay outstanding student loans!

The NHSC offers scholarships and loan repayment programs to help with the cost and debt for those pursuing careers in the fields of primary care, dental care, and behavioral health.

Both programs provide funds in return for service at an approved NHSC site in a high-need, underserved area.

For a two-year commitment to work at an NHSC-approved site, the scholarship program pays tuition, fees, educational costs, and provides a living stipend; the loan repayment program provides up to \$50,000 towards reducing student loan debt.

Sites include: American Indian Health Facilities, Community Mental Health Centers, Community Outpatient Facilities, Correctional Facilities, Critical Access Hospitals, Federally Qualified Health Centers, Private Practices, and Rural Health Clinics.

Applicants must be pursuing a degree in one of the following NHSC-eligible disciplines:

Primary Care: Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Geriatrics, Mental Health (MD, DO, NP, CNM, PA)

Dental Care: Family/General, Pediatric and Geriatric Dentists, Dental Hygienists

Mental and Behavioral Care: Psychiatrists, Health Service Psychologists, Licensed Clinical Social Workers and Professional Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, Psychiatric Nurse Specialists, Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants
