NATIONAL CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY Certification Training Program

COURSE INFORMATION

This training provides the basic technical skills, experience, and knowledge of the proper use and installation of child car seats that are needed when working with parents and caregivers with child passenger safety needs.

You must be at least 18 years old at the time the course starts. The child passenger safety technician (CPST) certification course is 3 days long and combines classroom instruction, hands-on work with car seats and vehicles. Attendance is required for the entire 3 day course at Comanche County Health Department.

COURSE CONTENT

This training will provide participants with the technical skills to:

- Identify and correct the misuse of child car seats
- Serve as a community child passenger safety resource and participate in car seat checkup events
- Receive knowledge to achieve national certification
