Osage County Community Partnership Board began as one of the community coalition projects of the Oklahoma Commission on children and Youth in March 2011. The OCCPB partnered with Turning Point in 2008 and a county wide needs assessment and senior living survey were conducted in 2011, The results focused new efforts on fitness and nutrition, senior adult living needs, drug education and prevention

The OCCPB has worked closely with the Osage Nation since 2004 implementing the communities of excellence tobacco Control Program funded through the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET). OCCPB focused its efforts on promoting the Certified
