About Us...

Osage County Community Partnership Board began as one of the community coalition projects of the Oklahoma Commission on children and Youth in March 2011. The OCCPB partnered with Turning Point in 2008 and a county wide needs assessment and senior living survey were conducted in 2011, The results focused new efforts on fitness and nutrition, senior adult living needs, drug education and prevention

The OCCPB has worked closely with the Osage Nation since 2004 implementing the communities of excellence tobacco Control Program funded through the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET). Osage County ranks 26 out of 77 counties as per

2013 County Health Rankings for health outcomes. OCCPB focused its efforts on promoting the Certified Healthy Oklahoma Program during 2012. OCCPB played a major role with other partners to arrange 6th Annual *Preparing for the 7th Generation: The Journey Continues.*



Gail Boe, chair OCCPB and director for Communities of Excellence is a member of Healthy Food Initiative team created by Principal Chief John Red Eagle. The team plans to start community gardens in all Osage districts.

To bridge the gap for access to

care, efforts are underway in Skiatook to bring a community health clinic to the town thanks to a federal grant and a \$75,000 matching fund from the Nation.

To provide healthy fruits and vegetables to the communities , a mobile grocery truck is selling food items in Fairfax. CX, also co sponsored a 5K race, a Fun Run (1 mile), an Amazing Race (8.2 miles) and a Little Amazing Race for younger children.
