4. With the proposed changes to the ACA and recommendations coming from the 1332 task force, what additional areas of the ACA should be analyzed for potential impact upon Indian health?
5. What are the most critical impacts on Indian health related to the Indian Health Care Improvement Act?
6. Are there intersecting points of the ACA Indian Health provisions and the recommendations presented by the 1332 concept paper?
