a. This is to incorporate the following:

Questions and Answers:

- 1) Will you entertain bids from out-of-state contractors? Yes
- 2) Looking at the Duties of the Contractor as listed in Section C.3 of the Solicitation (page 18) : Is the entirety of this work to be performed within the \$50,000 budget as stated on page 10? Yes, but if they have other funding to provide additional support for the duties they can use the additional funds to supplement.
- 3) Does the \$50,000 budget include the development OR purchase of curriculum? It could if they currently are not using curriculum that meets the national Health Education Standards.
- 4) Can you indicate how many schools will participate in the program and will be in need of curriculum, training and TA? A minimum of 50 schools throughout the state
- 5) Are you looking for one, comprehensive health education curriculum or 5 separate health curricula (One for each health topic)? It could be either way – CATCH is a curriculum for nutrition and physical activity while FitnessGram is for physical activity only. ETR has the HealthSmart curriculum that is prek-12th grade and covers topics from nutrition and physical activity to behavioral health, growth and development, bullying prevention, etc. What we are looking for is health education curricula that meets the national Health Education Standards.
