  - B. Proposal for new business:
    1. Data Systems Report shows a four (4) hour delay for high acuity patients to get from a lower level to a higher level facility.

      - b. When did patient arrive?
      - c. When was patient seen by provider?
      - d. When was decision made to keep or transfer the patient?

      - j. When did patient arrive at definitive care?
    2. Establish Trends in Delays.
  - C. It is very possible we can establish a system of care for day to day, destination plans for Trauma, Stroke, STEMI, Pediatrics and catastrophic emergencies, etc. We would like to work with the RTABS to create a consolidated regional plan. Region 8 and 7 are destination regions unlike the rest of the regions. Instead of just a trauma plan have a book that has appendixes for trauma, stroke, STEMI etc. We encourage this region to form working groups for Stroke and STEMI in your RPC meetings.

    - a. Tamara Fischer: Are the times available on the Trauma Registry and can they be added to provide visibility? Reply: Not all times are noted with the Trauma Registry. Recommendation to develop core measures for trauma.
    - b. Dr. Ogle: If RPC chooses to address stroke and stemi it is recommended that patients post resuscitation and septic patients be added to the study.
