- I. Call to Order: Meeting called to order @ 10:35 AM by Vice Chair Lori Smith.

- IV. Approval of Minutes – February 5, 2015: Motion – Memorial Hospital and Physicians Group, 2nd – Mercy Hospital - Healdton. Roll call vote, motion passed with a unanimous vote.
- V. Reports
 - A. Emergency Systems Report: Brandon Bowen reviewed upcoming changes in all the regions. OSDH will be providing more strategic direction to RTAB's when it comes to stroke and STEMI. All RTAB regions are being encouraged to develop working groups to discuss all time sensitive medical conditions. OSDH is working with regions to create consolidated regional plans specific to each region to determine destinations and resources for time sensitive medical conditions. It is also being considered adding REMSS deployment guidelines as a separate appendix within the consolidated regional plans. Consolidated regional plans will have a matrix that lists every hospital and EMS agency with their classification. Time sensitive medical conditions and plans can be discussed within the RTAB meetings. The projected go live date is January 1, 2016. Delays in patient transports were discussed. A vertical timeline will be added to the CQI case review to identify where delays are occurring. An OTERAC report was given. Identification and treatment of time sensitive medical conditions. OTERAC is asking the RTAB's to give feedback with time delays. The OTERAC meeting agenda has a place on the agenda for RTAB chairs to discuss their region. OTERAC strategic goals are the identification and treatment of all time sensitive medical conditions. Interoperability between diagnostic equipment and reading (i.e. CT scans and x-rays).

 1. Continuous Quality Improvement Sub-Committee: Charles McNear presented a "good case/bad case" report.
