- I. Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 1:03 P.M. by Sue Watkins
- II. Roll Call: Roll call by verbal response – Quorum met
- III. Introductions and Announcements: Sean Oats introduced Mr. Charles McNear as our Clinical Health Facilities Surveyor and he is also handling CQI at this time.
- IV. Approval of Minutes – October 7, 2014: Motion made by OSU Medical Dr. Blubaugh to approve minutes. Motion seconded by Saint John Medical Center Dr. Yeary. Roll call vote, motion passed unanimously.
- V. Reports:
 - A. Emergency Systems Report: Sean Oats
 1. Introduced Jeremy Cunkle and Richard Clarke as new Administrative Assistants for our Office they are not present today. James Wilkins has accepted a position with EagleMed and is no longer with our office.
 2. OTERAC working groups have met at least once. The RTAB Liaison group has asked that RTAB Chair's, Vice Chair's, RPC Chair's or anybody interested in participating attend the meetings. They suggest this would assist in the flow of information from the RTAB to OTERAC and back down to the RTAB.  4. PELA sites Mr. Eric Chase has done some leg work on this. We have received about 1000 sites from a couple of air services. We are in the process on looking at these sites to see which ones are easy to access so EMS Services can meet ALS Services for assistance in areas they are not familiar with.

 - C. CQI Sub-Committee: Sue Watkins, Nothing to report. Charles McNear presented the RTAB with two cases from CQI. One of the cases was a good case and the second case was a bad case. These were presented for the RTAB to see what information the CQI Committees are receiving. Next quarter we will present every case for your region that was not closed primary cases no follow ups.

 - A. Sue Watkins – Meaningful data for our Region.
 1. How do we refine the system? How do we make the system function to provide optimal care for the patients?
 2. Do we need more information about the resources available to us in our region?
 3. Needs of the injured patient.
 4. Rehabilitation of the patient. Not having rehab beds available for the trauma patient. Patients only have a limited time for effective rehab.



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5. Return to the community outcomes. What area's do we not have access for the trauma patient.
6. Not many ventilator rehab beds in this state unless you are a pediatric patient in this state.
7. National Trauma data bank Oklahoma is significantly lower than other states transferring to rehab. We thought we were doing good sending patients home but we are finding out this is not good because the patient should be going into rehab before they go home.
8. Are patients being allowed to return back to their community to repatriate once the initial trauma has been taken care of?
9. How do we pick that sub set of patients data that we really need to study?
10. Suggest that we use the sub set of patients that the ACS criteria for level one activation or the activation of the trauma team. Looks like the sub set of patients that we need time and triage data back on from the state. Are there other indicators besides these? Anatomic Criteria.
11. Did the times really affect the outcome of the patient? What patients did not receive a good outcome?
12. Time of initial transfer request data should be tracked at Saint Francis now. TReC is now tracking the data of when the patient arrived at the facility on calls they receive.
13. Rehab needs to provide data on how their system is functioning.
