The Wagoner Family Service Council became a Turning Point partnership on March 14, 2007. WFSC had several projects years. They added Walk This Weigh to Wagoner Family Fun Day. Participants received a pedometer when entering the park. They had to complete 2,000 steps before receiving an incentive prize.

The WFSC started two subcommittees focusing on health and tobacco prevention. They received Turning Point/WIC funds that allowed them to put on the first annual WAYUP youth conference that focused on Real World issues, fitness, nutrition tobacco prevention and underage drinking prevention. They were able to put in a basketball court at Wagoner Community Outreach. Several members of WFSC serve on the Arkansas Verdigris Valley Health Center in Porter. The health center had its grand opening on March 10, 2007.
