COWETA/EAST BROKEN ARROW

- 2001 Activities
 - The group formed in June with the Chief of Police for Broken Arrow and the City Manager from Coweta coordinating the partnership.
 - The county line between Tulsa and western Wagoner County is very blurred. Economic expansion has occurred while delivery of health services has not.
 - Completed a community survey that will be mailed soon to the citizens of the area in order to better assess the community needs.
 - Began preliminary meetings with DVIS because of the increasing need for a domestic violence shelter in the area.

- Outcomes
 - The survey will be mailed to 1,000 residents
 - Have been included in some of the strategic planning processes for DVIS to discuss the feasibility of a Southeast Shelter.
 - Lines of communication between the two communities have improved.

- Future Plans
 - Will be decided after the results of the survey.
