

About Us...

Delaware County Community Partnership formed sub-committees this year to work on drug awareness and working with Cherokee Nation's CAN program (to reduce substance abuse).

We sent several youth to a 2M2L mini northeast Oklahoma camp. The youth are looking at alternative programs including coffee shops and skate parks. DCCP has recognized the need to help provide clothing for low income students, and plan to participate in a community clothing drive at the end of 2007.

DCCP is working on a community Drug Awareness Workshop. They worked on a poster campaign educating the community about the fines to selling and giving alcohol to minors. Fifty posters were distributed to convenient stores. They are currently planning and reforming board for 2008 activities.

Significant Outcomes:

- ◆ Selling & Giving Alcohol to Minors poster campaign was displayed in convenient stores in Delaware County
- ◆ Received Turning Point/WIC funding for nutrition and physical fitness activities helping create new partnerships for future activities
- ◆ Distribution of nutrition and physical activity banners and signs throughout the county
- ◆ Able to fund and deliver over 50 car seats
