**LINCOLN COUNTY**

- 2002 Activities
  - Established health priorities for the partnership: community health clinic, substance abuse, nutrition, childhood immunizations and adult immunizations
  - Developed subcommittees to work on the feasibility of having a community clinic in the county
  - Developed By-laws for the Community Health Clinic
  - Started a Pharmacy Distribution Center
  - Developed and distributed a community health survey
  
- Outcomes
  - Low-Income individuals with ongoing pharmaceutical and medical expenses are able to get their prescriptions filled at a greatly reduced cost. There is an income-guideline.
  - Partnership of strong, dedicated individuals committed to address the health issues of the community (county).
  - Found a couple of potential locations for the community health clinic.
  - Over 300 surveys were returned.
  
- Future Plans
  - Establish a Community Health Clinic for low-income families with insurance.
  - Expand partnership.
  - Develop a Community Health Improvement Plan.
  - Participate in the OSU Listening Conference.
