- **Activities**
  - Have primarily worked on partnership sustaining activities, seeking new community partners and fund raising for most of the year.
  - Have had multiple meetings regarding the pros and cons of becoming a Federally Funded Health Care Center. (\*\*NOTE: Board has voted to continue the current procedures of funding our clinic through community donations)
  
- **Outcomes**
  - The clinic has now provided *over 1 Million dollars* worth of free services and prescription medications!!
  - After 15 years of unsuccessful attempts from numerous community and neighboring agencies, Mayes County's Turning Point representative, Darla Thompson, was able to network with dental providers locally and an Oral Surgeon in Tulsa to establish a Free Dental component to their Free Medical Clinic. Services will include the initial screening all the way up to and including Oral Surgery. *A first for Mayes County!!*

  - Future plans include building on to the clinic to offer several more specialty clinics. Building supplies have been donated, carpenters have volunteered their services, and the new specialty doc's have also pledged to volunteer their time and skills.
