

Since 2001 this rural coalition has been working hard to make a positive impact on the health of their community. From early activities such as Walk This Weigh and annually collecting Christmas gifts for county children to more recently combining resources and efforts with other local groups and securing funds for coalition activities this partnership continues to work to address the needs of McIntosh County.

Also known as McCoCo, the McIntosh County Coalition has received funds for a Drug Free Community Program and a grant from OCCY to expand the resources and the services of the group. They have combined efforts with a local board working on a new building to house several of the coalition's member agencies as well as a local non-profit agency committed to decreasing the ill effects of tobacco use.
