PUSHMATAHA COUNTY

- 2001 Activities
 - Pushmataha County Turning Point Coalition (PCTPC) formed
 - Applied for SICA grant to implement a community-based substance abuse prevention program
 - PCTPC identified and will focus on (1) comprehensive school-based education, (2) community development and awareness and (3) peer/mentor initiative between the adult community and the youth
 - Applied for community-based drug prevention grant with the Antlers public school system
 - Applied for community-based drug prevention grant with the Clayton public school system
 - Developed resources for nutrition center in the Finley community

- Outcomes
 - Received SICA grant \$100,000 per year for three years
 - Received the community-based drug prevention grant for Antlers public school system for \$8,500 per year for three years
 - Received the community-based drug prevention grant for Clayton public school system for \$8,500 per year for three years
 - Food Nutrition Center for the Senior citizens established in the Finley community

- Future Plans
 - Establish a smoke alarm program in the Antlers, Moyers, Rattan, Clayton and Finley communities
 - Expand the partnership
