About Us...

Wagoner Family Service Council developed an Action Plan that identified the need to work on building a stronger coalition. The coalition will focus on transportation, after-school programs, and behavioral health services.

The **Systems of Care** (Behavioral Health) Committee has been working on three priority areas this year. Wagoner County received a Systems of Care grant. The committee is partnering with CREOKS, Inc. and Wagoner County to plan, implement and evaluate programs. The Systems of Care program utilizes the Wrap-a-round service model of care. The committee is also working with Wagoner Public Schools in addressing the need for a Drop-Out Prevention Coordinator and a Behavioral Health Counselor in the schools.

The **Tobacco Committee** received a Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET) grant for a Community of Excellence award in the amount of \$190,000. The committee plans to continue its work with adult cessation programs and youth prevention programs. However, the committee is also looking into the need for youth-oriented cessation programs.

The **Senior Committee** continues to work with local agencies that serve the seniors of Wagoner County.

The **Health Committee** has selected obesity and nutrition in schools as a priority area. The committee will begin working with the Turning Point Field Consultant to develop a strategic plan, mission statement, and vision for the committee.
