



Q: During the past 7 days, on how many days were you in the same room with someone who was smoking cigarettes?

One in 3 students reported they had been in a room daily with someone who was smoking (past 7 days). Rates were slightly higher among girls than boys. Current smokers were more than twice as likely as students who are not current smokers to report they are daily in a room with someone who is smoking cigarettes.


Percent who were in a room daily with someone smoking (last 7 days) by SCHOOL GRADE




Percent who were in a room daily with someone smoking by SCHOOL TYPE



Percent who were in a room daily with someone smoking by SCHOOL TYPE and GENDER




Percent who were in a room daily with someone smoking by CURRENT SMOKING STATUS and SCHOOL TYPE




Q: During the past 7 days, on how many days did you ride in a car with someone who was smoking cigarettes?

One in 5 students daily ride in a car with someone who is smoking. Rates increase from 15% among 6th graders to nearly 30% among 10th graders. Forty-one percent of current smokers report they daily ride in cars with someone who is smoking compared to 13% of students who are not current smokers.


Percent who daily rode in a car with someone who was smoking (last 7 days) by SCHOOL GRADE
