Course Overview: The Basic NIMS instructor course is a two course that is designed to provide the knowledge and skills to teach IS 100, 200 and 700 upon its completion. The first two modules will provide basic concepts of teaching the IS 100 and 700 courses with emphasis on the IS 200 on the final module. The second day will include a turn in the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security's Simulation Trailer. The simulation trailer is designed to test command staff principles under a controlled environment.

Prerequisites: IS-700, ICS 100 and ICS 200 and a basic knowledge of training and instructional concepts.
