Course Overview: Through the Office of Emergency Communications/Interoperable Communications Technical Assistance Program (OEC/ICTAP), the **All-Hazards Communications Unit Leader Train the Trainer (COML TtT)** Course is available to provide U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) approved, National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliant COML instructor training to ensure that every state and territory has trained instructors capable of instructing the COML course. Having state and territory qualified instructors will allow a self sustaining process for trained COMLs to manage and coordinate on-scene communications during multi-jurisdictional responses and planned events.

Prerequisites: ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, IS-700, IS-800b; All-Hazards COML Course; the instructor candidate must have a completed COML Task Book with all tasks signed.

Participant Audience: COML TtT Course is targeted for all local, regional and state cross disciplinary emergency response professionals with instructional and communication skills background.
