Course Overview: The unique personal protection challenges that responder's face during a weapon of mass destruction (WMD)/terrorist incident or a hazardous materials incident. Major course topics include assessing WMD hazards, predicting the likely behavior of WMD materials, effectively operating and communicating in a unified command structure of the Incident Command System, determining detection equipment and personal protective equipment needs, performing emergency decontamination, and identifying defensive strategies for a WMD incident. PER-212 is based on NFPA 472 (2008) consensus standard operations-level core competencies and PPE mission specific competency, OSHA (29CFR 1910.120) and EPA (40CFR Part 311) response regulations. This course provides the knowledge and skills needed to obtain certification through the National Professional Qualifications System (NPQS/ProBoard) as a Hazardous Materials Operations-level responder.
