Course Overview: This class is designed to address Awareness-level functions associated with WMD recognition, prevention, and deterrence applications for law enforcement officers. As such, it does not provide detailed technical information to include hands-on practice of actions required of law enforcement officers in WMD situations. The course will focus on the following modules: Intelligence, Resources, and Terrorist Operations, The Importance of the Law Enforcement Officer, Combating Terrorism, Recognizing WMD on the Streets, Terrorist Trends in Fraudulent Documents, The Vehicle Stop, and The Critical Role of Information Sharing

Prerequisites: Minimum of three years of service with a law enforcement agency, Instructor certification and endorsement by the appropriate agency training supervisor

Participant Audience: The law enforcement officer is part of the front line defense in preventing and deterring WMD terrorist incidents where the release of WMD agents is likely to occur because of criminal actions.
