Higher Education Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings (IRTB)

Course Overview: The course is an “awareness level” course designed to communicate basic information concerning explosive and incendiary devices that could be used as terrorist weapons. The course is comprised of classroom presentations designed to familiarize participants with commercial and military explosives, improvised explosive devices and appropriate response procedures. Classroom topics include:

- Understanding the terrorist threat and actions to help prevent and/or deter bombing attacks against campuses
- Basic information on explosive and incendiary devices that could be used as terrorist weapons
- Use techniques to prevent and/or deter terrorist attacks involving energetic materials
- Appreciate the necessity for respect for the destructive potential of energetic materials (Improvised explosive devices (IEDs)) that may be used in terrorist attacks
- Recognize, avoid, isolate and notify responders in the event of an event that involves explosives and incendiaries
- Departmental or agency policies to ensure compliance with local requirements

Participant Audience: These courses are intended for those who are responsible for responding to CBRNE incidents, including law enforcement, fire service, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), HAZMAT technicians, University Emergency Manager/Planners, Campus Security/Police - Chemistry Lab managers, Other Campus personnel, emergency management, public health, governmental administration, health care, public safety communicators, and public works. These courses will focus on response to Higher Education Terrorist Bombings.
