## NIMS Position Specific All Hazards Incident Commander (L 950)

**Course Overview:** This course is designed to provide local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Incident Commander (IC) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories: 1) responding to the incident and the command needs of the incident, and 2) effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of an Incident Commander on an All-Hazards IMT. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable students to process and apply their new knowledge.

**Prerequisites: Operational Experience Requirements:** Candidates for initial Position Specific courses must have a minimum of 2 years of operational experience. Operational experience is anyone that has been involved with emergency response and/or planning duties, or who has supported an emergency operation at or away from their agency or organization. **Certification Prerequisites Requirements:** IS-700a, *National Incident Management System, an Introduction*; IS-800b, *Introduction to the National Response Framework*; IS-701, *Multi-Agency Coordination Systems (MACS)*; ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300 and ICS-400.

**Participant Audience:** The target audience of this class includes emergency response personnel from multi-disciplines. These include but are not limited to: fire, law enforcement, emergency medical services, public health, emergency management, public works and local/county government.
