Preparedness and Response to Food and Agriculture Incidents (MGT-322)

Oklahoma City, OK November 16-17, 2011

Course Overview: This course is designed to promote community response and recovery from agriculture-based terrorism. Participants will be trained to identify and recruit those in their neighborhood whose daily activities place them in a unique position to identify potential threats to the cultivation, production, processing, transportation, or distribution of the nation's food supply. Participants will develop an incident response plan for their area, and learn to identify and obtain the local, state, and federal resources that can protect the agricultural resources of the United States

Prerequisites: Completion of a WMD Awareness-level training course and familiarity with the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the National Response Framework (NRF)

Participant Audience: The target audience is composed of representatives of local, state, and federal agencies; farmers, ranchers, commodities industry, livestock, grain, produce, food processors industries; and individuals involved in planning for and responding to food and agriculture incidents who have an interest in or an assignment to provide training to key members of community planning teams.
