Enhanced Threat & Risk Assessment (MGT-315)

Course Overview:

This course enhances the basic Threat and Risk Assessment course (MGT-310) by teaching participants how to apply all phases of the DHS/FEMA risk management process to jurisdictional critical infrastructure and key resources. Through lectures, discussions and classroom activities, participants learn methods to identify and prioritize risks from all hazards, assess vulnerabilities, estimate consequences, and use equipment, training and exercises to mitigate risk. Multidisciplinary participant teams visit and assess facilities selected by the host jurisdiction, determining risks, vulnerabilities, consequences and mitigation options specific to their assigned site. Teams then document their findings using a software assessment tool, develop an action plan, and present their results to the class. This course is CLEET Accredited.

Prerequisites:

It is recommended that participants complete either the TEEX online WMD Terrorism Incident Awareness (AWR-160) or TEEX Threat and Risk Assessment course (MGT-310). The DHS/FEMA NTED course AWR-160 is offered online by TEEX at <http://www.teexwmdcampus.com>.

Participant Audience:

The participant audience includes emergency response level, supervisory and/or management personnel who respond to or have oversight responsibility for incidents caused by terrorism, natural disasters, major accidents and all other hazards.
