## Operational Level Response to HazMat/WMD Incidents (PER-212)

Bartlesville, OK

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### Course Overview:

This 24 hour course focuses on the special challenges faced by emergency responders and first receivers in dealing with a Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) or terrorist incident. Upon completion, participants will be able to respond to a WMD/hazardous materials incident, be able to preclude the spread of the hazard to the public and the environment, be able to predict the likely behavior of hazardous materials involved in a Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) incident, identify the containers and the container markings, and to determine whether hazardous materials are involved while initiating a response plan, effectively work and communicate within an Incident Command System (ICS), determine the size and scope of an incident, and communicate this information to the appropriate parties, determine appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for a given hazardous material, as well as don, doff, and work in PPE and describe the need for and purpose of decontamination and perform emergency decontamination procedures, Select, implement, and assess the effectiveness of defensive strategies. This course will be ProBoard Certified.
