**Lieutenant Governor Askins to “Suit Up”**

OKLAHOMA CITY – Lieutenant Governor Jari Askins is asking fellow Oklahomans to lend a helping hand during next week’s annual “Suited for Success” clothing collection drive at the State Capitol on Tuesday, April 29<sup>th</sup>.

Suited for Success is a non-profit, Oklahoma City-based organization that provides professional and work-appropriate clothing to low-income women upon completion of job training and readiness programs.

“Suited for Success is a tremendously important organization to Oklahoma women. Their clients are well prepared for future employment because of the assistance and support they are provided,” Askins said.

“In doing so, the entire State of Oklahoma benefits from this organization’s efforts.”

Askins will join Executive Director Susan Walton at 11:00 am in the Supreme Court Hallway to begin accepting donations of clean, gently used clothing. Other items to be accepted include unworn shoes, unopened cosmetics and pantyhose, handbags, jewelry, scarves and monetary donations.

“Last year, we suited our 4,000<sup>th</sup> client. We hope to surpass that milestone significantly, and hope that Lt. Governor Askins’ support will enable us to achieve this goal,” Walton said.
