



Make a Family Preparedness Kit and be sure that you have a flashlight, battery-powered radio, extra batteries and a first-aid kit. Take your kit with you when you seek shelter.



Make an emergency plan with your parents. Hold a Tornado Drill. And if there is severe weather, stay calm! You know what to do if you have to take cover!



The safest place to be during a tornado is in the basement, under a heavy bench or the stairs. If you don't have a basement, go to an interior, windowless hallway, closet or bathroom on the lowest floor possible.
