**Summary:**

Revision #1974 is to approve a temporary pond (Pond #7). The pond is very small and is

designed to control runoff and sediment generated from a watershed of about 2.1 acres.

The revision is reviewed by Technical Services and is found to be adequate. Inspector's

recommendation for an approval is also included.

Based on a revision of the application for a permit revision, including all conditions and materials submitted up to this date, I find the following:

- The applicant has demonstrated that coal reclamation as required by the Act of 1979 and the Oklahoma Department of Mines Rules and Regulations (OAC 460:20) can be accomplished under the reclamation plan contained in the application;
