



TORNADO SAFETY

Tornadoes may appear nearly transparent until dust and debris are picked up.

Tornadoes often occur when it is not raining. Tornadoes are associated with a powerful updraft so rain does not fall in or next to a tornado. However, very large hail does fall in the immediate area of the tornado.

PLAN FOR A TORNADO

1. Learn about your Tornado Risk.
2. Pick a safe place to gather.
3. Discuss how you would be warned of an approaching tornado.
4. Conduct periodic tornado drills, so everyone remembers what to do when a tornado is approaching.
