



NOTICE: PRODUCTION FEE CHANGE

Title 45, Section 931

B. All operators of non-coal mining operations shall pay to the Department of Mines a fee of **one cent (\$.01) per ton** of mineral produced. For the purposes of this section, a mineral shall be defined as provided in Section 723 (4) of Title 45.

On June 6, 2010, Governor Brad Henry signed into law House Bill 1281 raising the current Non-Coal production fees, with an emergency clause.
The last fee increase was July 1, 1986.

Effective July 1, 2010 the new rate will be:
\$.01/ton of minerals produced.

***The NEW rate will be payable October 1, 2010 for the
quarter July 1, 2010 – September 30, 2010
(This is a permanent rate change, effective for every quarter hereafter.)***
