RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND MINE SITES



Be aware of who is on your mine site and for what purpose. Only allow authorized personnel in restricted and potentially dangerous areas. Unless your mine is staffed around the clock there will always be an opportunity for unauthorized access. Fences and locked gates help but cannot prevent a determined individual from entering the mine area.



Do not assume, "It will be okay, just this once." Think and act responsibly every day.

It is the permittee's responsibility to make sure only authorized personnel are on the mine site and that each individual is aware of the hazards around the mine.
