


# Good Housekeeping... The Key to a Safe Workplace

**Section 910.B.8** – Oxygen cylinders shall not be stored near oil or grease.

**Section 914.10** – Ladderways, stairways, walkways and ramps shall be kept free of loose rock and extraneous materials.

**Section 918.8** – Materials such as oil waste and rags which are subject to spontaneous combustion shall be placed in a tightly covered metal container until disposed of properly.



- Keep stairs clean. Stairways and walkways are not shelves. Do not store materials or allow hoses, cords or other obstacles to be stored there.
- Inspect your workplace and equipment daily to prevent trips and falls.
- Keep hand rails free of oil and grease.
- Be aware of loose material underfoot.
