New Permit

* **Title 460:10-17-5 of the Oklahoma Administrative Codes** requires an applicant to place an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the county of the proposed operation for at least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks when applying for a new permit.

Revision (Significant Departures)

** **Title 460:10-19-4(b) of the Oklahoma Administrative Codes** requires an applicant to place an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the county of the proposed operation for at least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks when applying for a permit revision.

Renewal

*** **Title 460:10-19-5(b) of the Oklahoma Administrative Codes** requires an applicant to place an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the county of the proposed operation for at least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks when applying for a permit renewal.

Transfer

**** **Title 460:10-19-6(c) of the Oklahoma Administrative Codes** requires an applicant to place an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the county of the proposed operation for at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks when applying for a permit transfer.
